

BYLAW 10/2005

**A BYLAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE TOWN OF HIGH PRAIRIE,
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE A SYSTEM OF NUMBERING HOUSES AND
BUILDING SITES WITHIN THE TOWN.**

WHEREAS: Council of the Town of High Prairie has the authority under Section 7(a) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto, hereafter referred to as the *Municipal Government Act*, to enact bylaws respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property; and

AND WHEREAS: The Council of the Town of High Prairie deems it necessary to establish a system of house numbering within the Town and to continue to maintain this system in order to provide Fire Protection and Emergency Services for the public of High Prairie in an expedient manner.

AND WHEREAS: The Council of the Town of High Prairie deems it necessary to establish a system of house numbering in order for town employees and Special Constables to execute notices and utility closures on property owners.

NOW THEREFORE: COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HIGH PRAIRIE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. SHORT TITLE

This bylaw may be called the “Numbering Bylaw”.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish and maintain a system of numbering houses and building sites within the Town of High Prairie.

3. BUILDING NUMBERING

- 3.1 A number shall be allotted for each new building when a building permit is issued.
- 3.2 Property owners shall be responsible for displaying the number of the building in a location, which is visible from the sidewalk or roadway.
- 3.3 Numbers are to be visible and legible from the street and located by/near the front door of the house and may be alit by an outside light.
- 3.4 Numbers are not to be obstructed by trees, shrubs or any ornaments hanging from the house.
- 3.5 Size of numbers should not be less than four (4”) inches in height and not blended in with the color of the house.
- 3.6 For the purpose of house numbering, numbers made of metal, plastic or wood are acceptable.

4. PENALTIES

- 4.1 A person who contravenes or fails to comply with any conditions, any order or request directed to him/her, pursuant to this Bylaw is guilty of an offence as listed in Appendix "B" of this Bylaw.
- 4.2 All fees, charges, and late payment penalties levied pursuant to this Bylaw are a debt due and owing to the Town of High Prairie and may be collected as such.

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon third reading

READ a second time this 24th day of August, 2005

READ a third time and finally passed this 24th day of August, 2005
